## Our Commitment

At the Taylor Centre for the Performing Arts we are committed to creating a safe environment while providing standout event and theatre experiences. We are now open, you can attend our events with confidence knowing that we have measures in place to keep all guests and patrons safe.

Effective Monday September 20, we have implemented the Restriction Exemption Program (REP) in our facilities. To ensure the health and safety of our audience, staff, artists, and our on campus community, proof of vaccination will be required for those 12 and older to enter the Taylor Centre (Bella Concert Hall).

## Vaccine & Tickets

By purchasing a ticket on our [ticketing page](#), you subsequently declare that you and your entire party are vaccinated or have received your first dose of the vaccine. Proof of a single dose will be accepted until October 25, 2021.

### October 25 and Later:

Two doses of a two-dose series are required, with the second at least 14 days prior to attending. For international travellers, the ArriveCan app code and a valid international travel identification document is acceptable.

### Proof of Vaccination

Your proof of vaccination must display the name, type of vaccine and the date it was received. This can be a paper COVID-19 vaccination record or shown on an electronic device from:

- Mount Royal University (MRU Now)
- Alberta Health Services
- A First Nation
- Your Pharmacy
- Your Physician
- Another Province, Territory or Country
- Canadian Armed Forces

We will not accept COVID-19 tests as a substitute for proof of vaccination unless it is accompanied by a valid medical exemption letter and conducted within 48 hours of attendance.

## Masking



Wearing a mask is mandatory indoors. The removal of your mask is only permitted when consuming food or beverages and should not be removed for an extended period of time.

Please note that performers will not be required to wear a mask or physically distance while on stage.

We will be monitoring the COVID-19 situation closely, and will update our protocols accordingly. Please refer to your performance's event page for show-specific information and continue to check back regularly prior to visiting the Taylor Centre.
